**OET** is for Health Professionals to meet their English Language proficiency to register and practice as a medical professional in Australia or New Zealand. AHPRA ((Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency). has set standards for health professionals and OET is one of this

**OET Preparation Course** give special emphasis on language requirement in a health care settings for health professionals. This course is designed to meet the standards required by AHPRA ( (Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency). This is an intensive course in order to gain the fundamental knowledge, test taking techniques and skill set.

**Duration** of the course is determined after an initial assessment of each student through 20 minutes test. Then course duration is recommended to students from one month to three months. There is tutorial and practice test all throughout the course. the course.

**The class methodology** is to cover all four modules namely Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking well as other sub skills such as vocabulary, Grammar, word stress, pronunciation, speed reading, scan for main points, lips and tongue techniques and speak with fluency.

**Course Topics** are from health related subjects to have relevance to the profession. And some tests are very specific to the selected profession. These are widely selected from Australian content to understand the Australian requirement as a Nurse, Doctor, Physiotherapy, Dentist, Pharmacist, speech Pathologist, etc.
